



ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS – ANNUAL TYPE A PAVEMENT MARKING

Sealed bids for ANNUAL TYPE A PAVEMENT MARKING for the Town of Abingdon, Virginia will be received by Matthew Bolick, Director of Public Services and Construction until **2:00 PM local time, Thursday, May 24, 2018**, at the Municipal Building, 133 West Main Street, Abingdon, Virginia 24210 at which time they will be opened and publicly read aloud. Copies of the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS may be examined or obtained at the above location. The work will consist of 4-inch VDOT Type “A” striping with of some 12” and 24” markings at various locations in the Town of Abingdon, as directed by the Director of Public Services and Construction.

Sealed proposals shall state on the outside of the envelope the company's name, address, and “**BID PROPOSAL - ANNUAL TYPE A PAVEMENT MARKING**”, addressed to the attention of Matthew Bolick, Director of Public Services and Construction, P. O. Box 789, Abingdon, Virginia 24212. Bidders must be licensed as a Class A Contractor in the Commonwealth of Virginia and prequalified with the Virginia Department of Transportation. All work shall conform to VDOT Road and Bridge Standards and Specifications. The bidder’s attention is directed to the requirements of Title 2.2 Chapter 43, of the Code of Virginia and Chapter 2, Article V of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Abingdon. The procedure for withdrawal of bids shall conform to Code of Virginia, Section 2.2-4330.B.(1). The bidder shall give notice in writing of his claim of right to withdraw his bid within two business days after the conclusion of the bid opening procedure and shall submit original work papers with such notice. The Town reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularities or informalities in the bidding, and to accept the proposal which, in its opinion, will be in the best interest of the Town.
