They have added a 4.5 - 5 feet delineating landscape island between the parking lots, and stated that they are willing to work with the Town Arborist to make sure they are in compliance with expectations.

At this time, as previous concerns had been addressed, Councilman Humphreys moved to accept the Certificate of Appropriateness application, as presented, except for the tree species that will be worked through with the Town Arborist and Captain D's planting commission. Second by Mr. Shuman.
