- d) Charge-off of FY2018 Uncollectable Debt Secretary explained that uncollectable debt in the amount of \$1,877 has accrued over the last year from unpaid rent. Secretary does not think this

- amount is collectable. Motion to approve by Commissioner Meek and a second by Commissioner Appleby. All in favor, motion carries.
- e) Utility Connection/Security Deposit Assistance Program Secretary presented guidelines and brought up questions regarding the development of a program to assist applicants with pre-move-in expenses. Board agreed that further discussion on this issue is necessary. No decision reached.
