Discussion ensued with regard to continuing the Arthur Campbell Awards. Decision was made to table this matter until January 2019 at which time it would be revisited.



Discussion ensued with regard to the maximum number of days for operation by a host. Jason Boswell, Interim Director of Planning answered questions regarding proposed solutions. Tony Sullivan, Interim Town Manager stated that staff was working with AirBnB to enter into an agreement for the collection of lodging taxes. Council agreed to revisit this matter at the September 18<sup>th</sup> work session.

**F. DISCUSSION REGARDING A CROSSWALK LOCATED IN THE VICINITY OF 619 WEST MAIN STREET (VIDEO 1:13:34 – 1:35:17)**
