# TOWN OF ABINGDON COUNCIL WORK SESSION MONDAY, JUNE 1, 2015 – 6:00 P.M. COUNCIL MEETING ROOM – MUNICIPAL BUILDING

A Work session meeting of the Abingdon Town Council was held on Monday, June 1, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the Arthur Campbell meeting room of the Municipal Building.

The following items were discussed by Council:

- 1. Mayor Morgan reported that Mr. Humphreys would be late arriving to the meeting as he was being treated at Urgent Care for a minor health issue.
- 2. Cecile Rosenbaum, Assistant Town Manager provided an update on the possible upgrade of microphones and cameras in the Council Chambers. Ms. Rosenbaum indicated that IT Director, Floyd Bailey, was proceeding with the purchase of additional cameras for the Council Chambers to improve viewing of Council meetings via online streaming. Ms. Rosenbaum noted that the microphone system in the Chambers was adequate for online meeting streaming if spoken directly into at very close proximity and an upgrade would be a costly item that has not been budgeted in the upcoming fiscal year.
- 3. Matthew Johnson, Director of Planning, provided information to Council on the construction estimates for stabilization of the Fields Penn House. Mr. Johnson noted that the total cost of the stabilization was \$160,000 which includes design and drainage reconstruction and bracing of the structure. Discussion ensued about the timeline for the project and Mr. Johnson indicated that timing was important in order to get construction done before the winter months. Mr. Kelly noted that Council could designate the total amount of funds left in

Council contingency totaling \$72,500 to the stabilization of the project with the remainder to come out of funds in the 2015/2016 budget. Ms. Lowe noted that Council was only considering only the stabilization of the structure at this time. Mr. Johnson reported that he planned to hold the first committee meeting very soon to begin discussions on the future of the house and Ms. Duehring commented on her interest in getting opinions from the public on future uses. Susan Howard commented that she hoped Council would consider a town hall forum for the public to offer comments on the uses of the House.

- 4. Mr. Kelly commented that he had received a letter asking localities to send letters of support to the Virginia Tourism Corporation regarding the branding of "Southwest Virginia". Ms. Lowe commented that this project was tied to funding from VTC and noted her support for the letter. Council members asked Mr. Kelly to send the letter of support to the VTC in support of the branding of "Southwest Virginia".
- 5. Susan Howard inquired about public art that she hoped to display near the English phone booths that have been recently installed.
- 6. At this time, On motion of Mrs. Lowe, seconded by Mrs. Duehring, the Council went into Closed Session pursuant to Section 2.2-3711(A)(3) of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, for the acquisition or disposition of real property for a public purpose.
