

**TOWN OF ABINGDON
BOARD OF ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW (BAR)
CALLED MEETING**

11 November, 2002 – 7:00 P.M.

A called meeting of the Board of Architectural Review was held on Monday, 11 November 2002, at 7:00 P.M in the Municipal Building, downstairs Meeting Room.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Charles R. Day, Chairman.

The minutes of the meeting of the Board of Architectural Review held on October 1, 2002 were approved as presented on motion of Ms. White, seconded by Mr. Phillips and unanimously adopted.

(2) Certificate of Appropriateness — Chris C. and Ann B. Johnson, (Copper Lantern Inn), Peyton Boyd, Representative), 133 East Valley Street, Abingdon, Virginia 24210; application for Certificate of Appropriateness for approval of 1) paint for siding, 2) materials for awning, and 3) stained glass window at rear of structure, for property located 133 East Valley Street. Tax Map No. 12 (1) 42. (Application attached - samples of materials/colors will be provided at meeting).

Mr. Johnson explained that these three matters were holdover matters from a previous meeting at which the plans were discussed. Mr. Johnson further explained that the paint for the siding would be Benjamin Moore "Dark Pewter", the colors contained in the awning would be a tan plaid fabric with green, red and other colors, and that the stained glass window was an old one that they had purchased from a dealer in Northern Virginia.

Upon motion of Mr. Phillips, seconded by Ms. White and unanimously approved it was resolved to approve the above items as per Mr. Johnson's request.

The Board of Architectural Review then began the second of a series of discussions and study of the proposed amendments to Article 8, the Old and Historic Zoning District. The Board covered the proposed Sections 8-1, 8-3, and 8-4 in their entirety. Section 8-5-1 was also discussed. The Board of Architectural Review adjourned at 9:48 P. M. to reconvene at 7:00 P. M. on 26 November 2002 for the purpose of continuing the discussion of the proposed amendments.
