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(3) CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS – **John E. and Annette P. Legard, Applicants/ Owners**, 179 Valley Street, NW, Abingdon Virginia, 24210; application for Certificate of Appropriateness for approval of gate and railings to be located at **179 Valley Street, NW. Tax Map No. 012 (6) 3A.**

Mrs. Annette Legard presented the board with an application for Certificate of Appropriateness for iron railings to be installed along the front steps leading to the house and the short steps leading to the sidewalk. The railings along the front steps would have three pickets, minimal scroll work, and would be simple in style, with a natural curve outward. The railings leading to the sidewalk would be similar in design, with one picket in the middle.

In addition, they would like to add an iron garden gate in front of the side driveway, which is currently being used as a garden area. The two side pieces would start at 48” high where they attach to pillars, and

decline to 30” tall. The gate in the center will be 30” x 30” and open back, into the garden area. They will all be black Powder Cast, which will protect them from rusting.

After discussion, Mr. Boyd made a motion to approve the items as presented. Mrs. Duehring seconded. Approved unanimously.

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(4) CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS – **Robin Mullins dba Forget-Me-Not, Applicant, Julianne Finney, Owner**, 129 East Main Street, Abingdon Virginia, 24210; application for Certificate of Appropriateness for approval of sign to be located at **129A East Main Street. Tax Map No. 012 (1) 92.**

Mr. Taylor presented the board with a Certificate of Appropriateness request for a sign to be installed at the business “Forget-Me-Not.” The sign fits within guidelines at 24” x 22” with a light blue border, white background, black lettering and will be installed over top of the previous sign.

After discussion, Mrs. White made a motion to approve the items as presented. Mrs. Duehring seconded. Approved unanimously.

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(5) REVIEW – Article 8, Old and Historic District, Local Historic Preservation Ordinance.

No discussion took place.

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(6) REVIEW – Historic Preservation Plan.

There was a continued discussion of the Historic Preservation Plan.
