



**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL FOR TOWN OF ABINGDON, VIRGINIA
APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

WHEREAS, Section 15.2-2223 of the Code of Virginia states that the local planning commission shall prepare and recommend a comprehensive plan for the physical development of the territory within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Section 15.2-2223 of the Code of Virginia further states that every governing body shall adopt a comprehensive plan for the territory under its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, a proposed comprehensive plan was properly submitted to the Town and reviewed by staff;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 15.2-2225 of the Code of Virginia, the proposed comprehensive plan was posted on a website that is available to the public;

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, at a duly noticed meeting on July 27, 2020, discussed the proposed comprehensive plan;

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, at a duly noticed meeting and public hearing on August 24, 2020, further discussed and resolved that it recommend that the proposed comprehensive plan be approved and certified a copy to Town Council;


