

## PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING BLACK HISTORY MONTH – FEBRUARY, 2022 BLACK HEALTH AND WELLNESS

WHEREAS, Black History Month is observed in February of each year; and

WHEREAS, Black History Month seeks to highlight Black history and is designed to recognize and pay tribute to the many contributions of Black Americans to the past, society, and culture of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the celebration of Black Americans' contributions to our history began in 1926 with Negro History Week, and each year since 1976, February has been designated Black History Month in our nation, and the President of the United States has proclaimed the month of February to be Black History Month; and

WHEREAS, the theme for Black History Month 2022 is Black Health and Wellness to acknowledge the legacy of not only Black scholars and medical practitioners in Western medicine, but also other ways of knowing throughout the African Diaspora; and
