VDOT has chosen Main Street Abingdon to complete a Pipeline Study. The study will review crash data, time of travel, access management, and functionality.

From that study we expect to see a list of suggested projects for Smart Scale Projects.

Staff will present at the Council's Mid-Month Meeting where the project currently is in the timeline and based on the type of study and expected outcomes. We will ask the following questions:


- 1. Does the Town of Abingdon want VDOT to push forward with this study?
- 2. Do Town Council Members want to sit on a subcommittee (if the answer above is a yes)?

Here are some of the interesting features of the study area!

- 1. Traffic flows fairly smoothly on Main Street.
- 2. We still have some of the highest concerned safety intersections in the Bristol District.



Congestion VTrans Need




- High need on US 11 between Cummings Street and Tanner Street
- Based on Travel Time Index (TTI)
 - TTI = Peak Travel Time Free Flow Travel Time





PROJECT PIPELINE

Potential for Safety Improvement (PSI)



- PSI is a measure of experienced crashes compared to expected crashes
 - Top PSI locations ranked within Bristol District
 - Multiple top-ranked intersections and segments within study corridor
