National Public Works Week Proclamation

"Advancing Quality of Life for All" - May 19-25, 2024

WHEREAS, public works professionals focus on infrastructure, facilities, and services that are of vital importance to sustainable and resilient communities and to the public health, high quality of life, and well-being of the residents for the Town of Abingdon; and,

WHEREAS, these infrastructure, facilities, and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals, who are engineers, managers, and employees at all levels of government and the private sector, who are responsible for rebuilding, improving, and protecting our nation's transportation, water supply, water treatment and solid waste systems, public buildings, and other structures and facilities essential for our citizens; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the citizens, civic leaders, and children in the Town of Abingdon to gain knowledge of and maintain an ongoing interest and understanding of the importance of public works and public works programs in their respective communities; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Abingdon, Virginia submitted an application for round six of Virginia Department of Transportation Smart Scale Evaluation Cycle for funding; and *WHEREAS*, Council for the Town of Abingdon support the following projects:

- French Moore, Jr. Boulevard Extension;
- U.S. 11 Main Street Improvements; and
- Cummings Street- Remsburg Drive Improvements

WHEREAS, Council for the Town of Abingdon supports the comprehensive plan, cooperation and continued transportation planning process to improve network connectivity and further safety enhancements.

WHEREAS, the Smart Scale is an application-based process available for regional agencies, counties, cities and towns, and public transportation agencies to apply for project funding.
